What is a Banner?

A banner is a flag that symbolically unites a group of people and helps identify them. It offers strength, encouragement, hope, and purpose.

The Lord is Israel's Banner

In the wilderness, Israel had to fight the enemies of God.

A unified Israel stepped out in faith and dependence on God, trusting He would bring them through the battle.

As Moses kept his hands raised in prayerful intercession, God gave Israel strength and victory.

God directed Moses to record this victory as a memorial so Israel would remember Him as their Banner.
