Complete Conviction

2:6-10

Paul records four truths about those who are confident of their identity in Christ.

- They have received Christ.
- They are _____ in Christ.
- They are rooted in Christ and are being built up and established in Him.
- They are thankful for what Christ has accomplished on their behalf.

Paul warns of those who present a gospel not centered on the person and work of Christ.

Paul declares Believers are made complete only by the sufficiency of Christ.

Stand firm on your identity rooted deeply in Christ, knowing that in Him you are complete.

Complete Salvation

2:11-12

Salvation is not based on our works, but entirely on the work of Christ.

When we receive Christ, we experience a spiritual circumcision of the heart.

When we receive Christ, we are immediately _____ with Christ.

Our salvation is accomplished by the power of God, not by the power of water.

Be assured of your salvation, knowing that Christ's redemptive work is sufficient.

Complete Forgiveness

2:13-15

Our sin is forgiven by grace through faith, based on the _____ work of Christ.

Through the death and resurrection of Christ, God triumphed over Satan.

Walk in a manner worthy of the gospel, knowing Christ has broken the power of sin's dominance in your life.

Complete Confidence

2:16-23

Paul speaks of a confidence based entirely on the _____ of Christ.

Paul warns the Colossians to avoid false teaching filled with worldly rules and regulations.

There is no need to add to what Christ has already accomplished on our behalf.

Live with complete confidence by knowing God's Word and staying focused on the person and work of Christ.

1 Corinthians 15:1-5

Now I would remind you, brothers, of the gospel I preached to you, which you received, in which you stand, and by which you are being saved, if you hold fast to the word I preached to you—unless you believed in vain. For I delivered to you as of first importance what I also received: that Christ died for our sins in accordance with the Scriptures, that he was buried, that he was raised on the third day in accordance with the Scriptures.

1 John 2:6
